ELIGIBILITY

- AIA Peconic members may submit projects located anywhere in the world.
- Registered architects whose current principle office or established satellite office of three years minimum is located in the chapter area, may submit projects located within the chapter's geographic boundaries.
- Architects may submit multiple entries per category.

CATEGORIES

To be eligible, work must have been completed after January 1, 2006.

ARCHITECTURE

The Architecture Awards celebrate outstanding architecture regardless of project size, budget, style, or building type. New buildings, additions, renovations, and restorations are all equally eligible. Entries are welcomed and encouraged from both established and new practitioners.

INTERIOR ARCHITECTURE

The Interior Architecture Awards acknowledge outstanding building interiors. Entries may be large or small in scope and may involve new construction, renovation or restoration.

PROJECTS

The Projects Awards recognize unbuilt architecture, planning, urban design, and research. The work must have been commissioned by a client with the intention to build and have been initiated after January 1, 2006. Projects cannot have been undertaken for academic credit.

AWARDS

Awards shall be given at the discretion of the Jury.

HONOR AWARD Excellence in innovative design strategy from Plan/Parti through to the finished imagery and/or completion.

MERIT AWARD Exemplary execution of design principles and presentation.

JUROR AWARD Recognizing excellence in resolving specific programmatic desires through, interpretation of style; technologies; sustainability; materials and/or vernacular influences.

SYMPOSIUM AND PUBLICITY*

AIA Peconic will announce the winners during a public symposium at the Water Mill Atelier, 903 Montauk Hwy., Water Mill. A jury consisting of three renowned design professionals, familiar with Eastern Long Island's diverse styles and sensitive environment, will present and comment on the winning entries. Following the juror's presentations, will be an open dialogue about the projects that garnered the attention of the jury.

REGISTRATION

AIA Peconic, upon receipt of the completed entry form with payment, will send the entrant a registration number and a registration package, which includes submission requirements. AIA Peconic will not be responsible for delays in delivery of registration materials. Submissions that are late or do not meet the stated requirements will be disqualified. Entry fees are non refundable. All deadlines are for receipt of the required material at the AIA Peconic office, not for its postmark.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Submission requirements are included in the registration package and can be reviewed on the AIA Peconic web site: www.iaipeconic.org

Award Entries shall include all information stipulated in Awards Program Instruction Sheet.

BINDER 8 1/2" X 11" or similar

Printed Drawings; Renderings; Images; Photos shall be 15 pages or less, including Data Sheets, Mission Statement, and Digital Disc.

DIGITAL Disc

JPEG Images 300 dpi, formatted in pages that replicate the Binder. Indicate 5 Favorite Images/Photos for Symposium Power Point and 2 Best for AIA Peconic Website.

BRIEF 500 words or less

Describe Program, Context, Intent, and Strategy.

Submissions that are late or do not meet the stated requirements will be disqualified.

RETURN OF SUBMISSIONS

Submissions that include a stamped, self-addressed mailer will be mailed back. Submissions may also be picked up at the chapter office between October 25th and November 5th. Those remaining will be discarded. Winning submissions may be retained for possible publication. AIA Peconic will not be held responsible for the condition of the returned submissions.
