The jury, consisting of three renowned design professionals, familiar with Eastern Long Island's diverse styles and sensitive environment, will present and comment on the winning entries. Following the juror's presentations, will be an open dialogue about the projects that garnered the attention of the jury.

### ELIGIBILITY

- AIA Peconic members may submit projects located anywhere in the world.
- Registered architects whose current principle office or established satellite office of three years minimum is located in the chapter area, may submit projects located within the chapter's geographic boundaries.
- Architects may submit a maximum of 3 entries per category and a maximum of 4 entries for the 2011 program.

### CATEGORIES

#### 1. ARCHITECTURE

The Architecture Awards celebrate outstanding architecture regardless of project size, budget, style, or building type. New buildings and major additions are eligible. Submissions in this category must have been completed after January 1, 2007.

#### 2. HISTORIC PRESERVATION/ADAPTIVE RE USE

Acknowledge projects that restore, remodel, preserve or re-purpose existing buildings of any type or style. Submissions in this category must have been completed after January 1, 2007.

#### 3. PROJECTS

The Projects Awards recognize unbuilt architecture, planning, urban design, and research. Submissions may be real or conceptual but must reflect a solution related to the built environment. Submissions in this category must have been active (On-the-Boards) after January 1, 2007.

### AWARDS

Awards and or special awards shall be given at the discretion of the Jury.

**HONOR AWARD** Excellence in innovative design strategy from Plan/Parti through to the finished imagery and/or completion.

**MERIT AWARD** Exemplary execution of design principles and presentation.

**JUROR AWARD** Recognizing excellence in resolving specific programmatic desires through interpretation of style, technologies, sustainability, materials and/or vernacular influences.

### SYMPOSIUM / MEMBER EXHIBITION\*

AIA Peconic will announce the winners during a public symposium at the Southampton Cultural Center, 25 Pond Lane Southampton. The symposium will run concurrently with the AIA Peconic Member Exhibition. (Information released separately)
