FINANCIAL AID SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2010

Purpose:

Financial Aid for one or more deserving East End students in Architecture.

Eligibility:

The Scholarship is open to any graduating high school senior, undergraduate or graduate student currently accepted by, or enrolled in a course of architectural study, at an accredited school of architecture. The student must have graduated from an east end high school; the east end is defined as the Townships of Riverhead, Southold, Shelter Island, East Hampton, and Southampton. If the applicant is awarded a Scholarship, he/she should be present at the July 8th AIA Peconic Dinner Meeting to accept the award.

A student may apply each year for a total of four years. The same student may also apply for the Merit Scholarship.

Award: up to \$4,500

Application: (if not complete the application will not be considered)

Provide each of the following:

- Scholarship Application Form
- Portfolio – two to five 8 ½ x 11 drawings or photos of current work.
- Statement in 500 words or less outlining how this award would benefit you.
- Resume/Curriculum Vitae
- Two Letters of Recommendation from Professors or Architects with whom you have worked.
- A digital record of the entire portfolio; each file should be preceded by YOUR name, i.e. *Smith.image3.jpg* or *Smith.image2.jpg*. No additional description is necessary in each file name
- Letter from your School's Financial Aid Office verifying need of financial aid.
- A self-addressed pre-stamped envelope if you would like the return of your portfolio and supporting material.
