



MERIT SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2010

Purpose:

Merit based Scholarship for an East End student of Architecture. A Jury of AIA Peconic Scholarship Committee Members shall review all entrees and award the Scholarship.

Eligibility:

The Scholarship is open to any graduating high school senior, undergraduate or graduate student currently accepted by, or enrolled in a course of architectural study, at an accredited school of architecture. The student must have graduated from an east end high school; the east end is defined as the Townships of Riverhead, Southold, Shelter Island, East Hampton, and Southampton. If the applicant is awarded a Scholarship, he/she should be present at the July 8th AIA Peconic Dinner Meeting to accept the award.

A student may apply each year for a total of four years. The same student may also apply for the Financial Aid Scholarship.

Award: up to \$3,000.00

Application: (if not complete the application will not be considered)

Provide each of the following:

- Scholarship Application Form
- Portfolio – five to ten 8 ½ x 11 drawings or photos of current work.
- Resume/Curriculum Vitae
- A digital record of the entire portfolio; each file should be preceded by YOUR name, i.e. *Smith.image3.jpg* or *Smith.image2.jpg*. No additional description is necessary in each file name
- Two Letters of Recommendation from Professors or Architects with whom you have worked.
- A self-addressed pre-stamped envelope if you would like the return of your portfolio and supporting material.
